The Social Justice School is identified as a Title I school as part of Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). Title I is designed to support State and local school reform efforts tied to the challenging State academic standards to improve teaching and learning for students. Title I programs must be based on effective means of improving student achievement and include strategies to support family engagement. What Is It?

This plan will be distributed at the Annual Title I Parent Meeting held in October of 2022 and it will be handed out all of our Family Engagement Events. The plan is also posted on our website. Our parents can also retrieve a copy of this plan in the Parent Resource Center located inside the Main Office of our school.

Building Our School Parent Compact

As part of this plan, The Social Justice School and our families will develop a school-parent compact. This collaborative compact document is an agreement that parents, teachers and students will develop that explains how parents and teachers will work together to make sure all our students reach and exceed grade level standards. The compact will be reviewed and updated annually based on feedback from parents and community members during the Annual Input Meetings.
