**A. Meeting Opening: Roll Call; Establishment of Quorum; Call to Order**

NRY called the meeting to order at 6:09pm and established quorum with 9 board members present.

NRY asked for a motion to approve the July board meeting agenda. JSG made a motion and SH seconded. The motion passed unanimously with no abstentions (JS was not present for this vote).

**B. Approval of May Meeting Minutes**

JSG moved to approve the May meeting minutes. TGB seconded. The motion carried with no abstentions (JS was not present for this vote).

**C. Voting on New Officer Roles**

NRY called for a motion to approve Yinnie Tse as the new Social Justice School board chair. TGB made the motion and SH seconded the motion. The motion carried unanimously (JS was not present for this vote).

EG made a motion to approve Caitlin Campbell-Hahn as the new vice chair. MD seconded the motion and it carried unanimously (JS was not present for this vote).

MD moved to approve Shannon Wright as the new board secretary. YT seconded the motion. It carried unanimously with no abstentions (JS was not present for this vote).

**D. Closed Session**

NRY called for a motion to move to close the meeting “to discuss trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from outside the government or public body, to the extent that disclosure would result in substantial harm to the competitive position of the person from whom the information was obtained;” pursuant to DC Code § 2-575(b)(11). CCH moved to move to closed session; TGB seconded. The motion carried unanimously and the board moved to executive session at 6:25pm.
